Though uncertain as to the exact amount of the CLAS cut, he said that the college was currently being asked for a five-percent “shopping list.” He said that the university and college need to consider ways, not just to cut, but to raise revenue—differential tuition, increased summer teaching, more effective recruitment of students from outside of the tri-county area.
