b. R th st ex m	equests revalidation of over-age credits: Over-age credits must be revalidated. If nere are over-age credits on the plan of work, the request must (1) explain how the rudent has kept abreast of current knowledge in the discipline during the period since the expiration of the last time limit; and (2) attest that the disciplinary content (theories, nethods, research findings, etc.) covered in the over-age courses at the time the student pook them is still valid.
sp b d	rescribes the plan to complete degree requirements during extension: Indicate becifically and in detail how the student will complete all remaining degree requirements before the new terminal date. If over-age courses cannot be revalidated, the graduate irector must indicate what the student is required to do in order to revalidate the credits and his/her knowledge in the field.
