

Physics 2131

Physics 2131 is the laboratory co-requisites for Physics 2130. It meets once each week for one hour and 50 minutes. The students are expected to be prepared for the exercises and follow the general guidelines set down in the Laboratory Manual. The manual is posted on Blackboard.

The grading scale is:

	$85\% \leq A < 100\%$
	$75\% \leq B < 85\%$
	$65\% \leq C < 75\%$
	$55\% \leq D < 65\%$
	$F < 55\%$

Each laboratory exercise is worth 10 points, except as noted below:

The quiz and the final lab session (cumulative lab test and evaluation) are worth 20 points. Persons failing to show up for any lab session will receive a zero for that lab. There are no make-up labs.

The lab scores are based entirely on what is handed in at the end of each lab.

The grade of Incomplete (I) will be assigned only if the student's situation completely complies with the rules promulgated by the university.

Grievance Procedure:

- a. Student must meet with the Teaching Assistant, one-on-one in private and discuss the issues.
- b. If disagreement persists, the Teaching Assistant and student will together, arrange a meeting with Dr. Payson.
- c. If disagreement continues after this meeting, the student may then contact the associate chair of the department, Professor Wadehra.

These steps must be completed in the order **a** first, then **b**, then **c**.
